

Dear Traveler,

We are excited to be returning to Scotland and Ireland again in 2022. We start in Scotland to fish two of the iconic salmon rivers, the River Deveron and the River Tay before heading over to Ireland to focus on the trout fishing resources in Ireland.

We will start in Scotland, famous for its magnificent scenery, festivals, historical architectural sites, Gaelic music and culture, the birthplace of golf, and over 100 Scottish whisky distilleries throughout the country. We will be splitting our time between two rivers. In Banff, we will be staying at Fife Lodge while fishing the River Deveron. In Perthshire, we will spend three days at Meikleour Arms to fish a beautiful stretch of the Lower Tay.

The fishing program in Ireland is quite different from some of our mainline fishing programs. We will be staying in a Glasha Farmhouse hosted by the welcoming host Olive Gorman. We will be delivered by private coach to Andrew Ryan's fly shop each morning to meet our guides. In the evening, we are delivered back to the Farmhouse for delicious home-cooked meals. It's a wonderful four days of fishing for brown and rainbow trout in the highly saturated green rolling hills and valleys of eastern Ireland. The small to medium size chalk streams are fairly easy to wade and navigate.

There is something truly special about the "Emerald Isle." The country is incredibly beautiful, complemented with warm Irish hospitality, great fisheries, a group of ghillies who are genuine characters, and wonderful meals and accommodations waiting for us each evening.

This is an excellent departure for non-anglers as well, with a guide and vehicle available for sightseeing each day. We look forward to sharing Ireland and Scotland with you on our trip.

What to Expect

- Atlantic Salmon in Scotland followed by private access fisheries for wild brown trout in south-central Ireland
- The accommodations range from private farmhouse stays to country hotels.
- This trip is excellent for non-anglers with daily sightseeing tours with a private driver and coach.

About the Accommodations

Scotland: In Scotland, spend three nights at Fife Lodge followed by three nights at Meikleour Arms.

Ireland: The group will have exclusive use of Glasha Farmhouse for five nights in the Nire Valley of Ireland.

Proposed Itinerary for Scotland and Ireland June 19 - 30, 2022

Sunday, June 19

Evening departure from the United States for overnight flight service to Aberdeen, Scotland. We will investigate the very best schedules and fares.

Monday, June 20

Morning arrival in Aberdeen, Scotland.

After collecting your luggage and clearing customs, your driver will meet you in the Arrivals Hall. He will escort the group to a private coach and will be with you for the duration of the itinerary in Scotland. Proceed to Fife Lodge with sightseeing en route.

Located in the historic seaside town of Banff, Fife Lodge is a delightful Country House Hotel. Set within its own private grounds, the hotel offers stunning views across the Deveron Valley.

Our eight en-suite bedrooms offer very comfortable accommodation. Furnished and equipped to a high standard, Fife Lodge is the perfect base for your fishing days.

Tuesday, June 21 – Wednesday, June 22

Two days of salmon fishing on the River Deveron.

Over the years the river has been renowned as a Salmon, Sea Trout and Brown Trout river. To this day the Deveron still holds the UK record for a Salmon caught on a fly by Mrs 'Tiny' Morison back in 1924.

Thursday, June 23

The group will check in Meikleour Arms for the following three nights.

The Meikleour Arms is a boutique country hotel in Perthshire conveniently close to the lower and Middle Tay beats, recognized as some of the best salmon fishing water in Scotland. Meikleour Arms has 11 stylish bedrooms renovated in 2017 to accommodate super king beds and luxurious marble bathrooms.

Nearby towns in the area include Perth, Scone, Blairgowrie, and Dunkeld.



Friday, June 24 – Saturday, June 25

Two days of Salmon fishing on the River Tay.

The River Tay is the longest river in Scotland, internationally renowned for its Atlantic salmon fishing, and one of the best salmon rivers in the United Kingdom.

You will fish a beautiful stretch of the lower River Tay, offering superb fly fishing and the best fishing hut on the Tay that has a dining area and toilets. Your days include a professional fishing guide offering advice on river craft, spey casting tuition, fishing techniques, premium salmon fishing tackle, and transport. Riverside lunches can be provided.

Sunday, June 26

Transfer to Edinburgh for flight to Dublin.

The group will check-in at Glasha Farmhouse for five nights on exclusive use basis. Glasha was recently awarded 2020 B&B of the Year by Georgina Campbell Irish Food & Hospitality Awards.

Glascha Farmhouse is a 5-Star country house in the picturesque Nire Valley with a spacious lounge with a cozy fireplace, conservatory, and dining room. Each of the eight en suite bedrooms provides beautiful views of the gardens, mountains, or landscape.

There are beautiful scenic walks around the house, and it is also possible to fish on site. Clonmel is a 20-minute drive from Glasha, and there is plenty to see and do in the area.

Monday, June 27 – Wednesday, June 29

Four full days of guided trout fishing through Clonnav Fly-Fishing, owned and operated by Andrew Ryan.

Frontiers has represented Andrew for a number of years. He has been guiding the River Suir and tributaries since he was a teenager. Clonnav's guides are talented professionals, excellent and enthusiastic teachers, passionate fishermen, and genuinely fun people to spend time with streamside. Clonnav also has a fully stocked fly shop. Guests have access to almost twenty miles of private fishing—almost all of which is within ten miles of your hotel. In addition to the River Suir, you will have the opportunity to fish the River Nire and the River Tar.

For any non-anglers in the group, Clonmel is centrally located with convenient access to the Rock of Cashel, Kilkenny Castle, Cahir Castle, Swiss Cottage, and Lismore. Plus, there is great hiking in the region. The driver/guide escorting the group will be available to take non-anglers on sightseeing trips daily while anglers are on the water.

Breakfast and dinner will be served at the Glasha Farmhouse. Anglers will enjoy streamside lunches.

Thursday, June 30

Depart Glasha and make for Dublin for Departure flight to the United States. Depending on flight times, an overnight in Dublin will likely be required

Scotland Inclusions: Meet and greet service at the Edinburgh Airport; private coach and driver for all transfers and sightseeing; three nights' accommodation at Meikleour Arms Hotel; three nights' accommodation at Fife Lodge; eight Salmon fishing permits for the River Deveron; four dedicated professional guides/Spey casting instructors (four rods each beat and two guides to

four rods); Salmon fishing permits on the River Tay for eight rods; four professional dedicated fishing guides; gourmet cooked lunch each fishing day with wine and whisky and refreshments (all locally sourced and organic ingredients); gear rental; and all applicable taxes.

Ireland Inclusions: Meet and greet service at the Dublin Airport, private coach and driver for all transfers and sightseeing, five nights of accommodation at Glasha Farmhouse, four days of guided fly fishing with Clonnav Fly fishing with permits and licenses, all meals for anglers, and applicable taxes.

Exclusions: Airline transportation; beverages (except where noted); gratuities for guides, hotel staff, restaurant staff, and the driver/guide; any items of a personal nature, such as tackle purchases, laundry, gift shopping, etc.; sightseeing entrance fees; package does not include lunch for non-anglers.
